

Rank requirements for Research Track

Appointment review will begin January 1, 2009

- Research Assistant Professor
 - Has funded position (not necessarily own)
 - Has demonstrated ability to publish
 - Letters will be internal
 - Appointment can only be for as long as the funding is there
 - Letter to dean needs to outline funding sources

- Research Associate Professor
 - Similar to previous but should have stronger academic record
 - Have some of his/her own funding (?>25%) or is actively participating in the writing of grants/projects
 - Has first/senior author publications
 - Mix of internal and external letters
 - Length of appointment only as long as funding available
 - Letter to dean must outline the funding sources

- Research Professor
 - Evidence of established research
 - Own funding (?>50%)
 - Evidence of a national reputation
 - Appointment length still needs to be linked to outside funding
 - Letters from the outside
 - Letter to dean must state funding sources
