Welcome and Introduction of those in attendance

Progress report of Adolescent Health & Resource Center

- Doug Smith gave an update on assessments at the AHRC for October 2003. There were 21 assessments scheduled for October. One client did not complete the assessment because of the parent's refusal to cooperate and who became potentially violent and was asked to leave. Of the 18 clients who completed the assessments, the following substance abuse recommendations were made: 4 no recommendations, 0 education/early intervention, 9 Level I outpatient, 4 Level II outpatient, and 1 Level III inpatient. (Level I is regular outpatient treatment, Level II is intensive outpatient treatment). There are 3 clients seen late in the month who have not yet received recommendations. Of the 21 clients seen, 16 were from Johnson County and 5 from Iowa County. Eight of the twelve clients that were eligible for the study agreed to participate.
- Mary Larew talked about the services of the free medical clinic on Wednesday afternoons. This venue is for clients who haven't access to insurance or Title 19 and have need for a limited medical examination.

Brochures

- Brochures were distributed to interested individuals.

Outreach

- An Outreach and Training Team has been organized to go into communities to speak with students, teachers, parent organizations, or counselors. They also want to give presentations to schools, service agencies, or other organizations.
- The use of the ICN was discussed. It was decided that each organization would check to see if the ICN should be utilized for future meetings in their area.
- Bonnie Winslow-Garvin and Amy Mason were re-introduced as the therapist and case manager for Iowa County residents. All appointments for assessments should go through the Adolescent Health & Resource Center (319-384-0847) in Iowa City but that the assessments and follow-up sessions would be held in Iowa County. It would be helpful if the caller mentions they are located in Iowa County when they call.
